### **Message from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services, Bureau of Prevention, Treatment, and Recovery**

DHS's Division of Mental Health & Substance Abuse Services is a state agency partner with the Department of Justice for the TAD – Treatment Alternatives and Diversion Project & Problem-Solving Courts. As of January 2015 Wisconsin has:

- 26 Adult Treatment Courts
- 15 OWI Courts
- 7 Hybrid (OWI & Drug) Courts
- 9 Veteran's Courts
- 2 Juvenile Drug Courts
- 2 Tribal Healing/Wellness Courts
- 3 Family Wellness Courts
- 1 Co-Occurring Disorder Court

The Wisconsin Treatment Court Standards Training will be offered this fall to these counties/tribes with a commitment to Evidence Based Practices which includes substance abuse treatment services. This collaborative effort is continuing to grow to assist clients in receiving treatment services as part of diversion program.
